WASC Senior College and University Commission Statement on the Status of Providence Christian College

On February 14, 2025, the WASC Senior College and University Commission (WSCUC) voted to impose Probation on Providence Christian College (Providence).

Probation reflects the Commission's finding that an institution fails to meet one or more of the WSCUC Standards of Accreditation. The Commission has determined that Providence Christian College is not in compliance with WSCUC Standards 3 and 4. When the Commission finds that an institution fails to meet one or more of the Standards of Accreditation, it is required to notify the institution of these findings and give the institution a period of time to correct the deficiencies. Under the Commission's policies the timeframe may not exceed two years. It is the responsibility of the Commission to determine, at the end of the sanction period, whether the institution has made the necessary corrections and has come into compliance with Commission Standards.

The accredited status of Providence continues during the Probation period and students' status within the college is not affected by this sanction.

The Commission's decision to impose Probation is subject to the terms and conditions contained in the Commission Action Letter dated February 27, 2025.
